CALL FOR PAPERS

For its 3rd session, the **Wine Law in Context International Seminar** still aims to bring together internationally recognized specialists in the sector of **wine & spirits law** but also **wine economics, sociology, ethnology or political science**. The key point of the Seminar is based on the idea that wine law can and should be apprehended and analyzed through a historic, geographic, economic and even political context.

For each session, a paper is presented either **in English** or in **French**. Priority is given to unpublished papers under process. The call for papers is also open to junior scholars, mainly PhD students.

Sponsorship of the Wine & Law Program allows covering accommodation and travel expenses for authors and/or discussants, within the limits of The Program's financial possibilities. For this year, priority will be given to papers from third countries.

The most authoritative papers are published online in **The Wine Law in Context Working Papers** (<http://wine-law.org/wp.php>), according to the editorial rules set by the Program.

Selection Process: For the academic year 2014-2015, a brief description (500 words) of the paper should be submitted together with the author's resume before **September 12, 2014 at seminar@wine-law.org**.
